Lovely aromas include red rose, violet, red berry, leather and baking spices. The bright, succulent palate doles out Morello cherry, mint, white pepper, balsamic notes and hints of coffee and vanilla alongside compact tannins. The Preda Sarmassa Barolo Riserva offers an interesting and immediate bouquet of cola, currants, dried mint, green olive and capers. This is a distinctive and special wine that would pair wonderfully against a meat dish with an herbal element. Try it with beef and mint jelly or herb-encrusted lamb chops. — **M.L.** *Published 12/1/2010*

Virna Borgogno 2007 Cannubi Boschis Nebbiolo (Barolo)

Barolo Cannubi Boschis (the designation name refers to which vineyard sites the fruit was harvested from) opens with a dark, garnet color and intense aromas of soft spice, brown sugar, cinnamon and ripe blackberry. This is a masculine, brooding wine with excellent aging potential.

From the celebrated Cannubi Boschis cru, here's a bright and luminous Barolo that opens with a deep ruby color and aromas of cherry, cola and cassis. Black fruit, tar and spice appear on the palate and the wine tastes tart, plummy and surprisingly succulent compared to most Nebbiolo-based wines.
